

Dear Parents and Guardians:

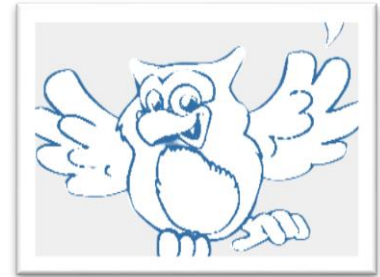
Welcome to Forest Hill Elementary School. We are proud of our dedicated, experienced staff and enthusiastic learners!
